Our sustainable principles

Our Sustainability Policy is based on these principles:

- To fulfil and exceed the requirements of applicable legislation, regulations and codes of practice.
- To consider sustainability in all business decisions.
- To ensure that all staff are aware of the Sustainability Policy and are dedicated to implementing and improving it.
- To minimise the impact on sustainability before, during and after any event that we trade at.
- To ensure our customers are fully aware of our practices, and encourage their engagement in assisting them to be achieved i.e. ensuring the compostable packaging ends up in a compost bin.
- To review our sustainability performance biannually, at the start and end of each Summer season.

Practical measures

1. Where possible, to use only local UK meat, cheese and vegetables so as to minimise transit emissions through importing and national transit.
2. To ensure that all of our meat has the 'Red Tractor' assured food standards stamp.
3. To separate our food waste and compostable packaging and provide our own compost bin at each event we trade at.
4. To ensure that any leftover food is used, eaten or donated.
5. To employ a team of similarly environmentally conscious staff, so as to keep a degree of excellence in our approach to sustainability.
6. To up-cycle our empty food tins and use them for things such as plants used to decorate the storage area in Somerset.

7. To use canned water rather than plastic bottled water.
